Official Rules and Regulations
September 10–30, 2013

For a list of Official Winners, please send a self-addressed stamped envelope to ILD 2013 Celebration Contest, PO Box 8190, Newark, DE 19714-8139. Please allow four to six weeks for delivery.

1. International Reading Association (IRA) is the sole sponsor (“**Sponsor**”) of the 2013 International Literacy Day Celebration Contest (“**Contest**”). Subject to conditions herein the Contest is open to classroom teachers of students 5-9, 10-14, and 15-19. IRA membership is not required to enter or win. No purchase necessary to enter or to win.
2. The Contest starts at 12:00 AM EST on September 10, 2013 and ends at 11:59 PM EST on September 30, 2013 (“**Contest Period**”).
3. The Contest is subject to these Contest official rules (the “**Official Rules**”), and by entering, each entrant (“**Entrant**”) agrees to be bound by them.
4. To enter: Tell us how you celebrated International Literacy Day in 2,000 words or less. Complete the registration form at www.reading.org/contest and click ‘SUBMIT’ at the bottom of the form to e-mail your entry along with your story, pictures, and any supplementary documentation to the International Reading Association at ILD@reading.org. Acceptable formats include Microsoft Word, PDF, and JPG.
5. Judging criteria: Winners will be selected based on originality; creativity; expression of the “Invent Your Future” theme; and suitability for possible use in Sponsor publications and websites, as interpreted by Sponsor staff.
6. Eligibility: The Contest is open only to individuals who are, as of the entry date: i) Classroom educators of students between the ages of 5 and 19; ii) who are legal residents of the 50 United States or the District of Columbia, and are at least eighteen (18) years old. Submissions must be centered on an activity that has taken place in a school setting. All submissions will be reviewed by staff of Sponsor to determine eligibility. Assessments will be conducted to ensure that submissions do not violate any rules(s), law(s), or policies of Sponsor, as well as adhere to the full contest rules herein. Employees and their immediate family members (spouses, parents, legal guardians, in-laws, grandparents, siblings, children and grandchildren) of Sponsor, Columbia TriStar Marketing Group, Inc. (“**CTMG**”), their respective officers, directors, affiliates, subsidiaries, parent companies, and advertising and promotion agencies (“**Contest Entities**”) and those living in the same household of same (whether legally related or not) are not eligible to enter or win.
7. Only ONE entry per teacher may be submitted.
8. Prizing: one (1) winner in the following age groups (5-9 years, 10-14 years, and 15-19 years) will be chosen to win one (1) Sony tablet (with an approximate retail value (“**ARV**”): \$499 US dollars) for their classroom.
9. Winners will be notified by e-mail. Awarding of prizes is subject to winners’ proof of eligibility. Although many will enter to win, only three (3) Sony tablets will be awarded.
10. Entrants must certify ownership of activities, stories, and photos submitted.
11. Entrants must get permission from the guardians of minors prior to submitting any images of them. Failure to do so may void your entry.
12. Any and all entries to the Contest shall, immediately upon submission, be deemed and shall remain the sole property of the Sponsor and will not be returned to Entrants. Contest Entities shall not be subject to any obligation(s) of confidentiality with respect to any entries. To the maximum extent permitted under applicable law Contest Entities shall not be liable for any use or disclosure of any entries under any circumstances whatsoever. Without limitations of the foregoing, Entrants and his/her parents/legal guardians, heirs and assigns (if and as applicable) hereby grant to Sponsor a worldwide, perpetual, non-exclusive license and right of every kind and nature throughout the universe in the entries, and Sponsor shall be entitled to unrestricted use of the entries and any derivative work created, produced or developed by Sponsor for any

purpose whatsoever, commercial or otherwise, without any compensation to Entrant or his/her parents/legal guardians, heirs and assigns (if and as applicable) or any other person or entity.

13. Winners may be asked to showcase their activity at a Sponsor event, function, or in print.
14. Any entry which is incomplete, illegible, or is not received by 11:59 PM EST September 30, 2013, will be ineligible and disqualified from entering the Contest.
15. Sponsor is not responsible or liable for any entry not received by Sponsor, including but not limited to difficulty accessing the Internet, the Contest link or the online registration form, service outages or delays, computer difficulties or other technological glitches or errors. Nor will Sponsor be responsible for any delays, difficulties, or errors or omissions caused by or related to wireless service providers, the U.S. mail service, private mail services or couriers utilized by any of Entrant or by the Contest Entities. Further, Sponsor reserves the right to terminate, cancel, suspend, or modify this Contest if Sponsor determines that fraud, technical failures, or other acts or events beyond the reasonable control of Sponsor have compromised the fairness or integrity of the 2013 International Literacy Day Celebration Contest.
16. By participating in the Contest, each Entrant agrees: (i) to be bound by these rules including, without limitation, all documentation and all applicable laws; (ii) to waive any rights to claim ambiguity with respect to these rules; (iii) waive all of Entrant's rights to bring any claim, action, or proceeding against Contest Entities; and (iv) to release, indemnify, and hold harmless each of the Contest Entities and each of their respective directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives and/or other authorized designees from liability (including, but not limited to, liability for any property loss, damage, personal injury, bodily injury, death, loss, expense, accident, delay, inconvenience or irregularity) that may arise in connection with Entrant's participation or inability to participate in Contest (and/or any parts thereof).
17. Winners must accept prizes within one (1) business week or five (5) business days of notification that they have been declared winners. Failure to accept and take delivery of the prizes within this time period will result in forfeiture of all rights and interest in the prizes. Except where prohibited, acceptance of the prizes by winning entrants constitutes a granting by winners to Sponsor of a non-exclusive, royalty-free, non-transferable worldwide license for Sponsor to use winners' names, images and likeness for marketing, advertising, promotional, and other purposes without additional compensation to winners.
18. The cash value of prizes will be reported by Sponsor to the IRS and any other applicable taxing authorities, as required by law. Any applicable taxes are the obligation of the winners. The winners must supply Sponsor with a completed W-9 form in order to receive the prizes.
19. If the winners cannot or will not accept the prizes, then the prizes will be forfeited, and awarded to alternate winners at Sponsor's sole discretion.
20. Sponsor, in its sole and absolute discretion, reserves the right to disqualify any entry or person from taking part in the 2013 International Literacy Day Celebration Contest for tampering with the entry process on the Sponsor website, or providing inaccurate or misleading information, or if an entry is not in full compliance with the Contest Rules.
21. Entrants upon submitting entry to the 2013 International Literacy Day Celebration Contest acknowledge and agree that Sponsor will have full power in any matter of interpretation and enforcement related to or arising from the Contest. Any eligibility, compliance issues or disputes related to or arising from the Contest will be subject solely to the decision and determination by Sponsor's Executive Director, at her sole and absolute discretion. In all instances, the Executive Director's rulings will be final and without further recourse.
22. Prize winners hereby acknowledge that the Contest Entities have neither made nor are in any manner responsible or liable for any warranty, representation or guarantee, expressed or implied, in fact or in law, relative to any prize or component thereof. Winners release, indemnify, and hold harmless Sponsor, CTMG, its directors, officers, employees, and agents (collectively known as the "**Released Parties**") from any injuries, loss, damage, or liability of any kind related to or arising from the 2013 International Literacy Day Celebration Contest or acceptance or use of the prizes won.
23. Any controversy, claim or dispute arising from or relating to the 2013 International Literacy Day Celebration Contest must be brought in any court of competent jurisdiction in the County of New Castle, the State of Delaware, to the exclusion of all others, and will be governed by and constructed in accordance with the laws of the State of Delaware without giving effect to its rules regarding choice or conflicts of law. The

invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of these rules shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision. In the event that any provision is determined to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable or illegal, these rules shall otherwise remain in effect and be construed in accordance with their terms as if the invalid or illegal provision were not contained herein. Each Entrant agrees that to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law the maximum liability of the Contest Entities under this agreement or related to or arising from the Contest shall be the approximate retail value of one (1) prize (\$499.00). In no event will the Contest Entities or each of their respective owners, directors, officers, employees, members, agents and representatives be liable for any consequential, indirect, special, punitive or incidental damages of any nature or for any reason whatsoever whether or not apprised of the possibility of any such lost profits or damages.
